

HEADS-UP Hold'em POKER

BONUS JACKPOT SYSTEM

The rules for the Heads up Hold'em Bonus Jackpot System at this casino (as set out below) are our commitment to players in ensuring that the gambling we offer is 'Fair and Open'. Any complaints or disputes should be brought to the immediate attention of Venue Management for resolution.

BONUS JACKPOT WAGER

- To make this wager, a player must place equal Ante and odds wagers and may place any optional bonus wagers.
- The wager must be placed on the betting sensor prior to all wagers being locked into play by the dealer.
- Once the dealer has 'locked out' the betting sensors, no more bets on these wagers can be accepted.
- Bonus Jackpot wagers with a ranking hand will be paid, irrespective of the dealer's hand.
 - Winning hands based on the players two cards and the 1st card in the flop.
- Wagers may be placed on the Red Bonus Jackpot sensor and/or where available, the Blue Jackpot sensor.
- Each coloured sensor will require a fixed stake to play, have its own independent Jackpot hand and own payable. (Please see table displays or ask a team member for information)
- If the player's hand is not one of the winning hands from the payable, the Bonus Jackpot wager will lose.
- In the event of a misdeal all wagers are void.
- In the event of a hand shuffle only game, the Bonus Jackpot(s) wager will not be available for play.
- All Three Card Poker and Heads up Hold'em Tables with Bonus Jackpot Systems in play within this casino are linked and contribute to the Jackpot total.

A PLAYER'S GUIDE TO THE HOUSE EDGE

The house Edge is a measure of how much the house expects to win, expressed as a percentage of the player's wager. For example, in a wager with the house edge of 5% the player will lose £5 for every £100 wagered. House edge varies by region, casino, and game. In some games, player betting or skills decisions can affect the edge, but it is important to keep in mind that the house always has some advantage against the typical player.
