## MEGA 38 PROGRESSIVE

## RULES FOR MEGA 38 PROGRESSIVE ON PUNTO BANCO

The rules for Mega 38 Progressive at this casino (set out below) are our commitment to the player's in ensuring that the gambling we offer is 'Fair and Open'. Any complaints or disputes should be brought to the immediate attention of Venue Management for resolution.

Mega 38 is when the player's third card is an 8 , and the Banker stands with a 2 -card 3 .

## Mega 38 PROGRESSIVE WAGER

- To make a wager a player must also make a standard Punto Banco wager on either the Player, Bank or Egalite.
- The Harmony Progressive is a wager valid for one hand only.

The Mega 38 Progressive pay table is as shown below.

| MEGA 38 (Suited) | $100 \%$ |
| :--- | :---: |
| MEGA 38 (Same colour) | $£_{4000}^{4.3000}$ |
| MEGA 38 Tie | $£_{2} 300$ |

Players must place a $£ 5$ bet to be eligible. Only the highest payout is paid per hand. All winners split the $100 \%$ jackpot. Each winning player receives a fixed pay. The progressive wager is not returned. All pays are 'for 1'. Players may have to wait up to 48 hours for payment of jackpot.

## A PLAYER'S GUIDE TO THE HOUSE EDGE

The House Edge is a measure of how much the House expects to win, expressed as a percentage of the player's wager. For example, in a wager with a House Edge of five percent the player will lose on average over time, $£ 5$ for every $£ 100$ wagered. House Edges vary by region, casino and game. In some games, player betting or skills decisions can affect the Edge, but it's important to keep in mind that the House always has some advantage against the typical player.
