

HARMONY PROGRESSIVE

RULES FOR HARMONY PROGRESSIVE ON PUNTO BANCO

The rules for Harmony Progressive at this casino (set out below) are our commitment to the player's in ensuring that the gambling we offer is 'Fair and Open' in accordance with the licensing objectives of the Gambling Act 2005. In the event of a dispute resulting from any ambiguity in the rules, the decision shall always be in the players favour until such time that ambiguity has been resolved.

HARMONY PROGRESSIVE WAGER

- To make a wager a player must also make a standard Punto Banco wager on either the Player, Bank or Egalite.
- The Harmony Progressive is a wager valid for one hand only.

The Harmony Progressive pay table is as shown below.

ALL SIX CARDS OF ONE RANK	100%
FOUR 8'S	£5000
ALL FOUR CARDS OF ONE RANK	£2000
SIX 0'S	£1000
EGALITE (same colour)	£100
ANY EGALITE	£10

ALL PAYOUTS ARE PER PERSON EXCEPT WHEN ALL SIX CARDS OF ONE RANK WINS. THIS JACKPOT IS DIVIDED EQUALLY BETWEEN ALL PLAYERS HAVING A HARMONY PROGRESSIVE BET ON THE WINNING HAND.

NB. RANK means cards of equal value

A PLAYER'S GUIDE TO THE HOUSE EDGE

The House Edge is a measure of how much the House expects to win, expressed as a percentage of the player's wager. For example, in a wager with a House Edge of five percent the player will lose on average over time, £5 for every £100 wagered. House Edges vary by region, casino and game. In some games, player betting or skills decisions can affect the Edge, but its important to keep in mind that the House always has some advantage against the typical player.
