RULES FOR LUCKY HARMONY PROGRESSIVE ON PUNTO BANCO

The rules for Lucky Harmony Progressive at this casino (set out below) are our commitment to the player's in ensuring that the gambling we offer is 'Fair and Open' in accordance with the licensing objectives of the Gambling Act 2005. In the event of a dispute resulting from any ambiguity in the rules, the decision shall always be in the players favour until such time that ambiguity has been resolved.

LUCKY HARMONY PROGRESSIVE WAGER

- To make a wager a player must also make a standard Punto Banco wager on either the Player,
 Bank or Egalite.
- The Lucky Harmony Progressive is a wager valid for one hand only and is not returned.
- Each winning player receives a fixed payout. Only the highest payout is paid per hand.
- ALL WINNING PLAYERS SPLIT THE 100% JACKPOT EQUALLY.

The Lucky Harmony Progressive pay table is as shown below.

FOUR-OF-A-KIND* (same colour)	100%
FOUR 8's*	£2000
FOUR-OF-A-KIND	£1000
SIX O's	£200
EGALITE (same colour)	£50
ANY EGALITE	£5

A PLAYER'S GUIDE TO THE HOUSE EDGE

The House Edge is a measure of how much the House expects to win, expressed as a percentage of the player's wager. For example, in a wager with a House Edge of five percent the player will lose on average over time, £5 for every £100 wagered. House Edges vary by region, casino and game. In some games, player betting or skills decisions can affect the Edge, but it's important to keep in mind that the House always has some advantage against the typical player.
